The service offers elective day care foot surgery in a community setting under local anaesthetic. Apart from diagnostics all care is undertaken on the same site and with a dedicated oncall service. We routinely audit all clinical activity and collect patient reported outcome measure (PROM) data which demonstrates improved health related quality of life for our patients following treatment.
