

Suspected Neurological / CNS Cancer NUH Pathway

NUH have changed their pathway for patients with a suspected Neurological / CNS cancer. In its place is a **Direct MRI** service and patients who have any of the following symptoms can be referred:

- - Subacute (approximately 6 weeks) progressive diplopia or hemianopia
- Progressive subacute headache plus features suggestive of raised intracranial pressure
- Subacute change in personality or behaviour
- Subacute progressive upper motor neurone symptoms
- Papilloedema (diagnosed by optician or GP)

Patients not meeting the above criteria will not be accepted for urgent imaging. If there is a specific query then please discuss with the on call Neurologist at NUH via switchboard or the Duty Neuroradiologist weekday 9am to 5pm at QMC (Ext 70377).
