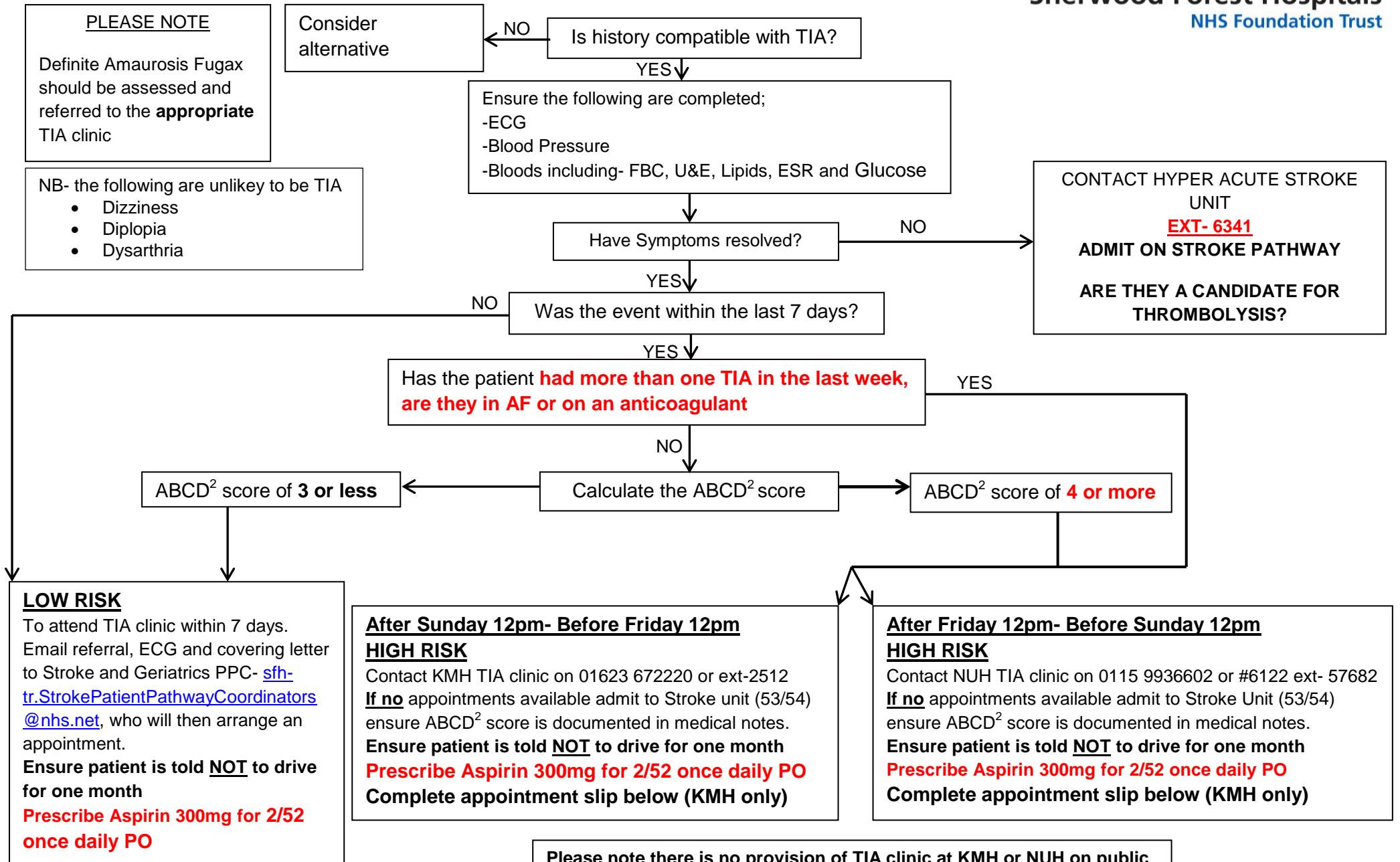


TIA Clinic Referral Pathway via ED/EAU/GP



PLEASE NOTE
Definite Amaurosis Fugax should be assessed and referred to the **appropriate** TIA clinic

NB- the following are unlikely to be TIA

- Dizziness
- Diplopia
- Dysarthria

Consider alternative

Ensure the following are completed;
-ECG
-Blood Pressure
-Bloods including- FBC, U&E, Lipids, ESR and Glucose

Have Symptoms resolved?

CONTACT HYPER ACUTE STROKE UNIT
EXT- 6341
ADMIT ON STROKE PATHWAY
ARE THEY A CANDIDATE FOR THROMBOLYSIS?

Was the event within the last 7 days?

Has the patient had more than one TIA in the last week, are they in AF or on an anticoagulant?

ABCD² score of 3 or less

Calculate the ABCD² score

ABCD² score of 4 or more

LOW RISK
To attend TIA clinic within 7 days.
Email referral, ECG and covering letter to Stroke and Geriatrics PPC- sfh-tr.StrokePatientPathwayCoordinators@nhs.net, who will then arrange an appointment.
Ensure patient is told NOT to drive for one month
Prescribe Aspirin 300mg for 2/52 once daily PO

After Sunday 12pm- Before Friday 12pm
HIGH RISK
Contact KMH TIA clinic on 01623 672220 or ext-2512
If no appointments available admit to Stroke unit (53/54) ensure ABCD² score is documented in medical notes.
Ensure patient is told NOT to drive for one month
Prescribe Aspirin 300mg for 2/52 once daily PO
Complete appointment slip below (KMH only)

After Friday 12pm- Before Sunday 12pm
HIGH RISK

If no appointments available admit to Stroke Unit (53/54) ensure ABCD² score is documented in medical notes.
Ensure patient is told NOT to drive for one month
Prescribe Aspirin 300mg for 2/52 once daily PO
Complete appointment slip below (KMH only)

Please note there is no provision of TIA clinic at KMH or NUH on public holidays and will require admission if indicated as per assessment.
