What to expect when attending the Memory Assessment Service (MAS)

Your GP has made a referral to the Memory Assessment Service following discussion with yourself regarding concerns around memory problems.

The team is coordinated by Belinda Baker (MAS Nurse).

The Memory Assessment Service run two clinics a week:

- ◆ Wednesday at Ollerton Health Clinic (last Wednesday of the month at Rainworth health Centre)
- ◆ Thursday at Byron House, Newark Hospital

Your appointment will usually last approximately 60 minutes and we always encourage people to be accompanied by a family member or friend if possible. A full assessment is carried out which will include discussing your current memory problems, past physical health history, any medication you may be taking and your ability to carry out day to day activities. We will also carry out a memory assessment test during the appointment and this will look at attention, memory, language, learning and recall.

We may also ask you to have further investigations carried out such as an ECG and CT head scan. These are routine requests and nothing to be concerned about.

The whole assessment is not designed to be intrusive but to help us gather as much information as possible in order that we can give accurate feedback during your follow up appointment.

The Memory Assessment Service will make a further appointment for you, by which time the assessment will have been completed, results received and reviewed by the Memory Assessment Service, and doctors who work closely with us. Here we will discuss our findings and explain what will happen next
