

NEWARK Locality General Practice based 24 Hour ECG Monitoring Service

PICS have a partnership with Broomwell Healthwatch to provide 24 Hour ECG monitoring from 3 local General practices as part of a Mid Notts CCG commissioned service.

Key Aspects of the Service:

- Broomwell offer a Consultant led interpretation service, have contracts with over 70 CCGS, to provide ECG monitoring and interpretation services to the NHS.
- AMBULATORY ECG 24 Hour monitor (holter) is an excellent diagnostic tool to diagnose a specific area, heart rhythm (Arrhythmias, AF, etc), over a 24 hour period
- Three Newark practices are trained up to provide appointments to fit the monitors, download monitor data and explain to patients how the service works.
- Appointments will be available at Lombard Street, Balderton and Collingham.
- All Newark practices can refer to the service by completing the referral form.
- Results will be available within 5 working days, sent direct to referring clinician.



- Simple light weight device, size of a mobile phone
- Attached by belt clip or pouch
- Data stored on memory card
- Data uploaded directly and securely to Broomwell web site
