How do you refer your patient?

Based on the assessment and Wells score you have completed if you **suspect a DVT** you do not need to initiate any tests or prescribe medication, just refer directly to us. We provide the clinical assessment and diagnostic pathway for all patients in Nottinghamshire 24 hours a day.
