### Restricted and Not Routinely Funded Policies

From 3 December 2018, our provider trusts are now using Blueteq. Blueteq is a web-based clinical decision support tool and was implemented as the CCGs standard electronic contractual prior approval system for procedures included in the Service Restricted Commissioning Policy.

Procedures covered will be extended in the future to include Individual Funding Requests. The Blueteq IFR system means that we have complete visibility of all requests, and their current status. All the communication and documents held on the system are available for subsequent review and the system provides a full patient history on a single screen with all associated documentation and notes immediately to hand.

**Unique Benefits of the system include:** Online submission by clinicians and cuts down on inputting mistakes and missing data. Patient History displays all information and documentation in one place in a paperless medium. No filing required and all vital data is immediately available to hand. An automated process to enable patients to be followed up in a timely manner. Ensure use of locally commissioned criteria. Production of vital reports takes minutes instead of hours to produce.. No software to install and maintain locally

### Update on localised services:

**MSK Hub** — ALL MSK (Orthopaedics, Rheumatology, Pain Management & Podiatry) and MSK Physiotherapy referrals should be sent to the MSK Hub via SystmOne and Ardens templates. The MSK Hub will undertake triage and manage the booking into the appropriate service. Any referrals sent directly to secondary care will be returned to referring GP practice for onward referral to the MSK Hub.

**Ophthalmology** – All referrals (with exception of red flags) to be sent to the provider via e-referral, where triage and onward booking will take place. These are the names of the services on e-referrals "Ophthalmology – Mansfield & Ashfield CCG only – Health Harmonie" and "Ophthalmology – Newark & Sherwood CCG only – Health Harmonie". Urgent referrals will bypass triage and be booked directly into provider of choice.

**A 24 Hour ECG community service is available to all practices.** For Newark, a referral can be made to Balderton PCC, Lombard Medical Centre, or Collingham Medical Centre via nhs.net, for all other localities please see the Inter-Practice Referral tab under the orange Ardens arrow for available provider practices. A referral template will need completing which is available as a pre-populating Ardens letter.

**Tele-dermatology service** is available for patients within Mid Notts provided by Circle Nottingham. If your practice has not received training/equipment please contact [susannah.jerome@nhs.net](mailto:susannah.jerome@nhs.net)

**Community Dermatology Clinic** - Practices are asked to send ALL adult Dermatology referrals (apart from 2ww and Tele-dermatology), and referrals for children with eczema to Dr Jeremy Hill via SystmOne referral. Clinics are held at Bilsthorpe Surgery and Kirkby Community Primary Care Centre.

**Gynaecology Virtual Clinic for Mid Notts**- Practices are asked to send all Gynaecology referrals (excluding red flags) for cervical polyps, continence, genital prolapse, heavy menstrual bleeding and PCOS to the new service at Major Oak (N&S) and Lowmoor Rd (M&A) via SystmOne e-referral.

## Children and Young People with Eating Disorders:

**Waiting Time Standards:** The Children and Young People with suspected Eating Disorders standard requires that, for **urgent cases**, patients should **wait one week or less** from referral to start of NICE-approved treatment from **1 April 2016**. For **routine cases**, patients should **wait less than four weeks** from referral to start of NICE-approved treatment. Please note that, as this is a new performance measure introduced in 2016-17, data collected in 2016 will inform trajectories for incremental percentage increases, with the aim of setting a 95% tolerance level by 2020.

## Early Intervention in Psychosis (EIP) and Improving Access to Psychological Therapies (IAPT):

**Waiting Time Standard:** The Early Intervention in Psychosis access and waiting time standard requires that, from **1 April 2018**, more than **53%** of people experiencing First Episode Psychosis (FEP) are treated with a **NICE-recommended package of care** within **two weeks of referral**. There are therefore two conditions for the standard to be met: a maximum wait of two weeks from referral, and treatment delivered in accordance with NICE guidance.
