Community Urgent Response and Rehab Team

CURRT

The Community Urgent Response and Rehab Team provide care navigation, urgent response and short term intensive rehabilitation to support timely discharge from hospital and prevent unnecessary hospital admission. The function of this team was historically delivered by Intensive Home Support (I.H.S) and Call for Care.

This is a 7 day service 8AM -10PM for people registered with a Mansfield, Ashfield, Newark and Sherwood GP practice. It is an Advanced Nurse Practitioner run service with Consultant Geriatrician support.

We are able to facilitate earlier discharges from hospital to support the patient at home for medical monitoring and rehabilitation and also provide care calls where there is an identified rehabilitation need.

The team consists of Advanced Nurse Practitioners, Clinical Assessors, Assistant Community Practitioner's, Healthcare Support Workers, Occupational therapy, Physiotherapy and Technical Instructors.

We work closely with Adult Social care who provide the interface between health and social care provision.

CURRT will provide:

Urgent response

- 2 hour face to face assessment to prevent hospital admission following referral to Call for Care option 1, from health and social care professionals
- Initiation of most appropriate community service and or signposting to other health and social care providers

Hospital at Home

- Diagnosis, treatment and review of medically unwell patients who do not require acute medical intervention and are stable to be cared for at home
- Seen daily by CURRT for up to 72 hours
- ANP led with escalation of care to Consultant Geriatrician if appropriate
- Interim care and support during period of optimisation / rehabilitation

Facilitate early discharge from hospital

- Supporting timely discharge for continued medical monitoring and /or intensive rehabilitation at home

Therapy

- Intensive, daily physiotherapy and Occupational therapy to support short term rehabilitation goals
- Provision of equipment to support independent with ADLs and promote rehabilitation and recovery
